

INFORMATION NEEDED FOR MEDICAL & DRUG ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

You will need to bring **Proof of Income**, for the **whole household**.

If you are retired the following information will be needed:

Social Security Benefit Letter,

Copy of Social Security Check, current copies

Of any pension or retirement checks,

The last Income Tax return, only if you have had income that you had to file on.

If you are **not** retired the following information will be needed:

Last 3 paycheck stubs OR Current Income Tax Return

We will need proof of anything that is considered income; this could include rent that you receive, alimony, child support, etc.

Bring all of your medicine with you to the appointment if you are applying for the
Medicine Assistance Program.
